
## Quartz Movement Replacement



## DISASSEMBLY

- 1. Carefully and individually, remove the second (9), minute (8), and hour (7) hands by applying slight pull pressure.
- 2. Remove the brass retaining ring (6).
- 3. Remove the white plastic washer (5).

The old movement can now be removed from the face.

## REASSEMBLY

- 1. Before installing the new movement, place the hanging bracket (2) over the center of the movement's shaft (1).
- 2. Align the movement's shaft (1) with the center hole of the clock face (3) and then place the clock movement through.
- 3. Place the white plastic washer (5) over the movement shaft.
- 4. Apply the brass retaining ring (6). Do not overtighten.
- 5. Place the hour (7), minute (8), and second (9) hands carefully and individually into the shaft.
