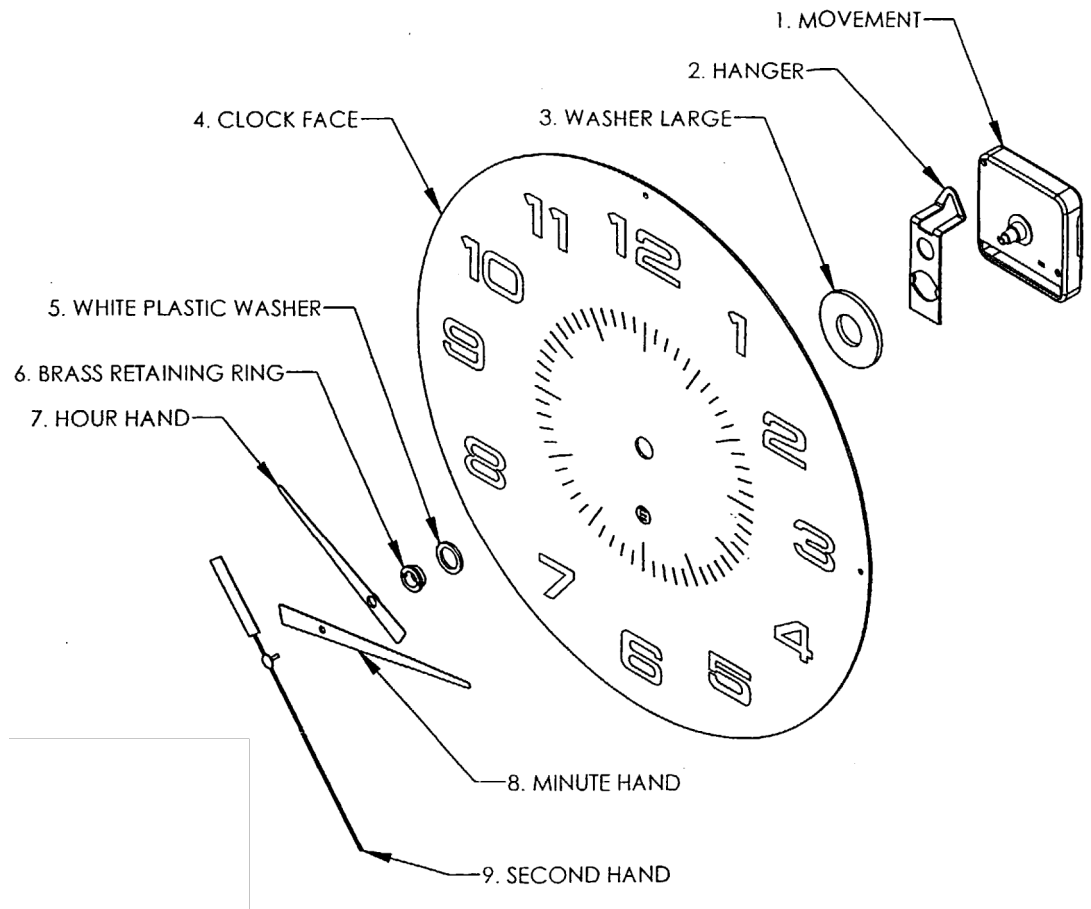


Quartz Movement Replacement



DISASSEMBLY

1. Carefully and individually, remove the second (9), minute (8), and hour (7) hands by applying slight pull pressure.
2. Remove the brass retaining ring (6).
3. Remove the white plastic washer (5).

The old movement can now be removed from the face.

REASSEMBLY

1. Before installing the new movement, place the hanging bracket (2) over the center of the movement's shaft (1).
2. Align the movement's shaft (1) with the center hole of the clock face (3) and then place the clock movement through.
3. Place the white plastic washer (5) over the movement shaft.
4. Apply the brass retaining ring (6). Do not overtighten.
5. Place the hour (7), minute (8), and second (9) hands carefully and individually into the shaft.
