
#### PRE-MOUNTED TAPE & SILICONE INSTALLATION

### Step 1: Corridor Placement

Install sign a minimum of 4" away from the strike side of the door.

All braille and tactile must be with the 48"-60" height on the wall to be ADA compliant. Ensure sign is level.






#### Step 1: Bedside Placement

Install with proper clearance area under sign to open door and side to side to open and change out icons.

Mark wall for correct placement.






# Step 3:

Apply silicone to back of sign. Silicone should be thicker than the tape trips.

Do not apply silicone too close to edges to eliminate any from being visible once sign is mounted and pressed against wall surface.


Peel backer from tape strips.



## Step 4:

Put sign in place on wall according to measurement you have previously marked out.

Ensure the sign is level and press firmly against wall.



### Step 5:

Clean sign face and edges of sign with mild detergent to remove all fingerprints.






#### **MECHANICAL HARDWARE INSTALLATION**
